- 5. The person authorising this payment cannot be, or be connected to, the payee.
- 6. A faxed copy of this form may be acceptable at our sole discretion.
- 7. CHAPS payment £25 plus VAT. The bank guarantees to make the payment by same-day transfer.
- 8. Faster Payment £15 plus VAT. The bank guarantees to debit the payment from your SIPP accounts within two hours. There is no guarantee when it will credit the recipient's account, though it is usually the same day. *Please note that the maximum amount that can be sent by Faster Payment is £99,999.99. If you select Faster Payment or do not specify the payment method and the amount to be sent is above £99,999.99, payment will be sent by CHAPS.
- 9. Cheque payment no additional charge. Cheque payments will be issued by post. Payment is cleared for withdrawal by the recipient in four working days.
- 10. BACS payment no additional charge. BACS is a three-day payment transfer, with funds crediting the beneficiary's account on the third working day.
